Worship Wonders

The first of the five movements in a worship service is the **Calling** of the Lord's people to gather. Several elements comprise the Calling, the first of which is often the **Prelude**.

The term "prelude" is formed by two Latin words "prae," meaning "before," and "ludere," meaning "to play." Over time, the prelude came to mean a preparatory piece of music to establish the setting and mood of the gathering. The prelude may also introduce the theme of the gathering. The prelude is often instrumental. Other times, the prelude might include the use of voices singing such as a choir, an ensemble, or a soloist. When the music is recorded and played over the sound system, we often sense it as simply background music. When the music is offered with live instrumentalists or vocalists, we might be more attentive to the music familiarizing ourselves with the service of worship that is beginning. Indeed, the performers have prepared and rehearsed the prelude music to bring it as an offering to the Lord as well as a ministry to our gathering. Whatever the offering, we encourage you to use this time to prepare your hearts and minds for worship.
