Consecrating

The third movement of a Christian worship service is the time of consecration. God called us together. He cleansed us from sin. Now God consecrates us with His Word. This act of consecration is described in Hebrews 4.12-13,

"For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart. And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account."

The imagery of the two-edged sword refers to the sword of the priest who would slay the sacrifice and cut it into portions to be arranged on the altar and transformed by the fire into smoke ascending to God (Lev 1.6). This process is emphasized in the second primary Old Testament sacrifice which was called the Ascension Offering (Ex 29.15-25). Today, as Christians in the New Covenant, Christ is our High Priest, who uses the sword of the Spirit which is the Word of God to transform worshippers as living sacrifices to be made fit for God's presence (Rom 12.1-2).
